WHY THE BAYLOR MBA HEALTH SPECIALIZATION: PRE-CLINICAL TRACK?

The Pre-Clinical Track (PCT) is an opportunity for eligible students to earn an MBA with Healthcare Specialization in one-year.

Eligible students include those who plan to attend an advanced clinical education program (e.g., medical school, dental school, physical therapy school) after completion of the MBA in Healthcare.
